Motion for a European Parliament resolution on abolishing the Green Deal

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 2 of the Treaty on the European Union,
- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,

A. Whereas significant shifts in geopolitical realities have occurred since the approval of the Green Deal;

B. Considering the ongoing farmer protests throughout the European Union, which underscore the adverse repercussions of the European Green Deal and its subsequent strategies, negatively affecting the daily functioning and future outlook of the European agricultural sector;

C. Considering the crippling effects the European Green Deal and its subsequent strategies have on our European industry, leading to deindustrialisation;

D. Considering the dramatic changes in the purchasing power of average households in the EU;

1. Emphasises the detrimental consequences of the Green Deal on the European agricultural sector, European industry and the purchasing power of ordinary households.
2. Urges the Council, the Commission and the Parliament to engage in renegotiations in order to abolish the Green Deal.
