Dear President,

We must express our <u>strong and unequivocal opposition</u> to the so-called "Chat Control" proposal currently being advanced under the Danish Presidency.

This draft regulation represents nothing less than a <u>blueprint for mass surveillance</u> of all Europeans. Under the false banner of child protection, it seeks to normalize the permanent scanning of private communications, undermine encryption, and establish an unprecedented system of digital control. Such a project has no place in a free and democratic Europe.

Our objections are clear and fundamental. By compelling providers to implement scanning before or after encryption, the proposal dismantles the very <u>foundations of Europe's digital security</u>. It would leave every European citizen and business more vulnerable to cybercrime, espionage, and authoritarian abuse. Furthermore, it effectively treats all Europeans as potential suspects, thereby eroding the rule of law and the presumption of innocence. The establishment of a permanent infrastructure for mass monitoring is both <u>disproportionate and dangerous</u>: once created, it is only a matter of time before it is misused.

It is deeply troubling that the Council is considering taking Europe down such an illiberal path. If adopted, Chat Control would mark a fundamental break with the European tradition of freedom and privacy, opening the door to abuses reminiscent of authoritarian regimes.

We therefore urge you, and all Member States, to <u>reject this dangerous proposal</u> <u>without delay</u>. Europe must never sacrifice the rights and freedoms of its citizens under the pretext of security. Child protection is vital, but it cannot and must not be used as a Trojan horse for the installation of digital mass surveillance.

History will not look kindly on those who dismantle encryption and open the gates to a surveillance society. The Council still has the chance to prevent this historic mistake.
