

In een reactie op sociale media verklaart Filip Dewinter dat: "I've just been banned from travelling to the UK by the Starmer Government. I quote: "My presence in the UK is not considered to be conducive to the public good". I was invited by my good friend Tommy Robinson to speak once again at the 'Unite The West' March this Saturday in London, but I won't be able to share my views with you because I am considered a - and I quote Starmer - 'far right agitator'.
